MANANA KOBALDZE

Manana Kobaidze worked at the Institute of Linguistics in Tbilisi (Georgian Academy of Sciences) in 1982-1996. Since 1996 she lives and works in Sweden, in Lund. She works with the projects "Language situation in Georgia" and "Minority languages in Georgia". Together with Karina Vamling Manana Kobaidze is a lecturer of the IT based course of the Georgian language. Manana is going to talk about the Soviet language and identity policy and the methods of its implementation in Georgia, also about the Post-Soviet results of this policy both for ethnic Georgians and ethnic non-Georgians in terms of integration and segregation.
